

Tall 2 Door Cabinet **Assembly Instructions**



90" tall x 48" wide x 24" deep | 90" tall x 48" wide x 20" deep 80" tall x 48" wide x 24" deep | 80" tall x 48" wide x 20" deep



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Oversized 4 Foot Wide Garage Cabinets

Here at A Better Storage Solution, we provide cabinets that are 90" or 80" tall x 48" wide x 24" or 20" deep (1200 lb total capacity).

Our Cabinets are not what you call butt jointed together but are interlocking together which are tongue and grooved.

We have leg levelers on the bottom of our cabinets for additional support. The 48" wide 24" or 20" deep cabinets come with 5 legs.

Our legs are ordered to fit. The options are 6", 9" or 12" high depending on how high your stem wall or foundation lip is in the back of the garage floor.

Our side panels, tops and bottoms of our cabinets are all 3/4" thick.

All our joints are glued together with type bond II glue for the best bond possible.

Our cabinets have no push pins, but instead have an exclusive Z-Clip for maximum shelf support. We have 1/2" thick backs so we can place a clip down the middle, so our shelves do not bow. The shelf rating is 350lbs per shelf.

We have adjustable slotted side walls that are one of a kind in the market.

The 3/4" thick shelves provided are slotted as well that allow them to slide over the clips and set down into them.

Our doors have 4 hinges each and are all mortised on the side of the door. They are stronger and built for garages and open a full 180 degrees.

Our garage cabinets are better than other online retailers because of our exclusive Z-Clip, 3/4" thick shelves (350 Lb. capacity) and of course our 90" or 80" tall x 48" wide x 24" or 20" deep size.

Other retailers only sale 32"-36" wide, 16"-20" deep and 80"-84" tall garage cabinets. We can give our customers a Superior AND Bigger Garage Cabinet for the same price.



2 Door Cabinet Assembly Instructions



Let's Begin...

Section 1: Toe Kick Assembly



Install the 5 leg leveler cups on all corners and center of the 16" deep x 47 1/2" Toe Kick shelf with the $\frac{3}{4}$ bronze pan screws provided.

Tape Measure can be helpful here.

When using a drill driver, do not over tighten. Always complete final torque with screwdriver to avoid stripping.




Mount all 5 leg levelers into mounting cups. This assembly is called the Toe Kick and is now ready for cabinet installation.

Turn the assembly over so that the levelers are facing the floor.


Place Toe Kick where the assembled cabinet will be installed.

Section 2: Frame Assembly





Using the provided glue, apply liberal bead on both side panel top and bottom ends.



Connect one right side panel to bottom and top fixed shelves.

Make sure black edges are facing down on all fixed shelves.

Use the 2" screws provided and drive screws into the pre-drilled holes.

When using a drill driver, do not over tighten. Always complete final torque with screwdriver to avoid stripping.



Connect the left side panel to bottom and top shelves.

Make sure black edges are facing down.

Use the 2" screws provided and drive into the pre-drilled holes.


When using a drill driver, do not over tighten. Always complete final torque with screwdriver to avoid stripping.

Section 3: Back Assembly



Apply the glue into the inside edges of the left and right-side panels.





Place one of the back panels into the side panel joints so the middle slots are facing down and the pre-drilled holes are facing towards top of cabinet.



Place the second back panel into the side panel joints so the middle slots are facing down and the pre-drilled hole are facing towards the bottom of the cabinet.

Square up cabinet by using a rubber mallet and tapping the corners so the back panels are lined up with each bottom and top shelf.

Layout the provided 1 1/2" screws needed to install on back panel.

Drive the 1 1/2" screws into the pre-drilled holes of both back panels around the whole perimeter of the back of cabinet.

When using a drill driver, do not over tighten. Always complete final torque with screwdriver to avoid stripping.

Section 4: Cabinet Install




Place Toe Kick against the wall or stem wall adjust leg levelers to desired height, and then level.

Find studs on wall to mount cabinet.



Stand up the cabinet with the back facing towards the Toe Kick and lean cabinet



Tip cabinet onto the Toe Kick and slide cabinet against the wall.

Drive the six 3 1/2" cabinet screws provided through cabinet back panels securely into the wall studs behind.

When using a drill driver, do not over tighten. Always complete final torque with screwdriver to avoid stripping.



STOP! You should be here.

If your cabinet does not look like this, please stop, go back, and re-read over the instructions again.

Section 5: Door, Shelf, Handle Assembly





Mount 4 hinges on each door by sliding the hinge into the mortise grove and tighten single screw plate.

> When using a drill driver, do not over tighten. Always complete final torque with screwdriver to avoid stripping.



Hold door securely and screw the 3/4 bronze pan screws provided into pre-marked holes on side panel.

When using a drill driver, do not over tighten. Always complete final torque with screwdriver to avoid stripping.




Close door and make sure door is square to the top and bottom shelves.

Tape Measure can be helpful here.



Screw the 3/4" bronze pan screws provided into pre-marked holes for the second door.

When using a drill driver, do not over tighten. Always complete final torque with screwdriver to avoid stripping.



Open and close doors and check to make sure there are both are level and plum.

If not level or plum, you may have to adjust by shimming the back of the cabinet out or hyper-extending one or more of the hinges so doors shut properly.



Mount handles with the 1" course threaded screws provided into the pre-drilled holes and tighten until handle is secure.

LIMITED LIFETIME WARRANTY

For a period of (30) thirty days from the date of purchase, should you not be satisfied with your product, you are entitled to a full refund less taxes, shipping & handling costs paid by the buyer.

What Is Covered? A Better Storage Solution. (ABSS) warrants its cabinet materials from manufacturing defects and defects from the product's workmanship for the lifetime of the product. The Limited Lifetime Warranty applies to the original Purchaser. The original Purchaser must provide the original sales receipt and proof of purchase from an approved dealer with any request for warranty claims.

What Will ABSS Do? During the warranty period, ABSS will repair or replace any product that fails to perform to ABSS specifications. Such repair or replacement shall be determined by ABSS and shall be limited to necessary adjustments or parts replacement and does not include re-installation at the installation site. Re-installation is the responsibility of the original Purchaser. This warranty does not cover any labor costs associated with service, removal or re-installation of parts. At the option of ABSS, the original purchase price may be refunded to the original Purchaser for a full refund and complete compensation of defect. Please contact the ABSS Dealer with whom the original purchase was made. Taxes, shipping and handling charges will be the sole liability of the original Purchaser.

What Is Not Covered? The warranty applies to the original Purchaser for home, personal use only. No coverage is provided if the product is transferred to another structure. The original Purchaser must provide proof of purchase and the original receipt for coverage to be in effect. The warranty will be in effect only when the storage unit is properly installed by the original Purchaser or certified dealer and the defect is not a result of improper or abusive treatment or improper installation. Coverage is not provided for discoloration, corrosion, rust or physical damage. Damage is not covered if storage loads are not evenly dispersed, as outlined in this manual, or the maximum load capacity exceeds 350 lbs per shelf or 1200 lbs per cabinet. If any other parts (not provided by the ABSS manufacturer) are used in conjunction with the ABSS product, the warranty shall be void.

THE WARRANTY WILL NOT BE IN EFFECT SHOULD THE INSTALLATION NOT ADHERE TO THE PUBLISHED INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS PROVIDED WITH EACH UNIT. THE WARRANTY DOES NOT PROVIDE COVERAGE IF THE PRODUCT MALFUNCTION IS DUE TO SHIPPING DAMAGE, PRODUCT MODIFICATION, IMPROPER INSTALLATION, IMPROPER MAINTENANCE, EFFECTS FROM BEING CONTACTED WITH A VEHICLE OR ANY OF ITS PARTS, OR CLAIMS MADE OUTSIDE THE WARRANTY PERIOD.



In the absence of an implied warranty period under state law, seven years shall be the term of the implied warranty. ABSS makes no other warranties under the terms of the Limited Lifetime Warranty and the option of repair or replacement is ABSS's only obligation. ABSS is not responsible for any other special, consequential (including substrate failure) or incidental damages resulting from the purchase or installation of the unit, regardless of cause. Liability for any such losses (including, but not limited to, financial loss, or loss of facilities use) regardless of cause or breach of implied warranty is expressly disclaimed and excluded herein. Upon installing any ABSS cabinet storage unit, the customer agrees that he/she is utilizing the ABSS cabinet storage unit for personal, non- commercial, use only. By installing any ABSS cabinet storage unit, the customer agrees to the warranty and agrees that the delivered product was to his/her satisfaction and that installation was done per the - instructions outlined in the "Assembly Instructions" manual provided with the purchased unit.

How State Law Relates To The Warranty: Please consult your state's laws regarding warranties. You may have rights in addition to the Limited Warranty. Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts or limitations on incidental or consequential damages. So the above limitations or exclusions may not apply to you.

Outside the 50 United States and Canada, this warranty does not apply.
